Individual's seeking to speak to the board will be allotted (3) minutes each. Time allotted for public comment is nontransferable. Those wishing to speak to the board should contact the Clerk at the School Board Office at (276) 694-3163. Normally, speakers will be scheduled in the order that their requests are received until the entire allotted time slot has been used. Where issues involving a variety of views are presented before the board, the board reserves the right to allocated the time available so as to ensure that the board hears from different points of view on any particular issue. Specific personnel and student issues will not be heard by the board in open session. Speakers are urged to contact the School Board Office in advance of the meeting. Because of time limitations, those persons who have not previously registered to speak prior to the day of the board meeting cannot be assured that they will have an opportunity to appear before the board. In order to make the limited time available most effective, speakers are urged to provide multiple written copies of their comments or other material amplifying their views.
