

ACCIDENTS AND EMERGENCIES

The superintendent shall protect the health of all students in case of accidents and emergencies. He/she shall implement plans whereby students may receive immediate competent medical attention. The board shall not assume any responsibility for the cost of medical treatment whether due to accident or illness.

If an injury to a student requires removing the student to a doctor's office or a hospital, a member of the school staff shall remain with the student until a parent or guardian has been contacted and arrives on the scene.
