

REPORTING TO PARENTS

A. Progress Reports

Progress reports shall be given to the parents or guardians of each student at regular intervals during the school year. The reports shall inform the parents or guardian as to the student's academic progress, attitudes, work habits and special needs or achievements. Classroom teachers shall be responsible for evaluating the students.

B. Parent Conferences

The school board encourages parental conferences as a means for discussing and amplifying a student's evaluation.

X. Encouraging Parent to Assist Student at Home

Each school must develop guidelines encouraging parents to provide instructional assistance to their children in their home. The central office staff will coordinate voluntary training for parents of children in the grades K through 3.
