

## AWARDS FOR STUDENTS

The school board approves of awards for students who achieve high academic standing, outstanding citizenship, physical expertise and other characteristics. The school board, however, does not approve of giving awards to students when the basic purpose is obviously commercialism. Awards sponsored by a nonschool agency that are recognized nationally and/or that are approved by the board may be given to students at appropriate ceremonies and times as the superintendent approves.

Awards to students that merit recognition by the public may be approved by the board for presentation during graduation ceremonies.
