

GIFTS BY STUDENTS

The exchange of gifts between individual students and teachers or other school personnel is discouraged. Discretion on the part of school personnel must be used to avoid embarrassment to the student. The board does encourage students and parents to show their appreciation for the efforts of school personnel through the use of letters and cards.

Funds of a student organization may be used to purchase a gift for the school, for scholarships, for contributions to or for the establishment of loan funds for students continuing their education after graduation or for other gifts to organizations approved by the principal. No student funds shall be used to purchase gifts for an individual without prior approval of the superintendent.
