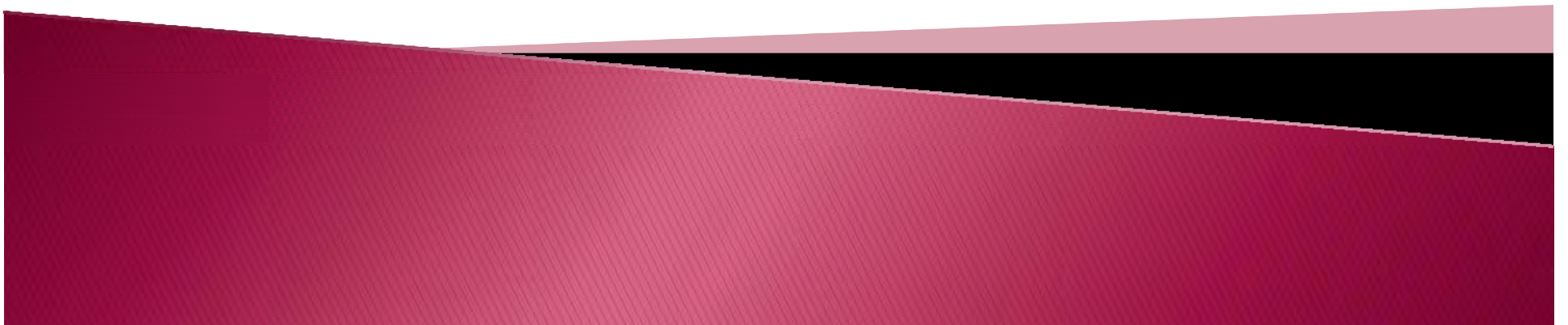

- ❖ Title I is a federal program that provides additional math and/or reading instruction for students.

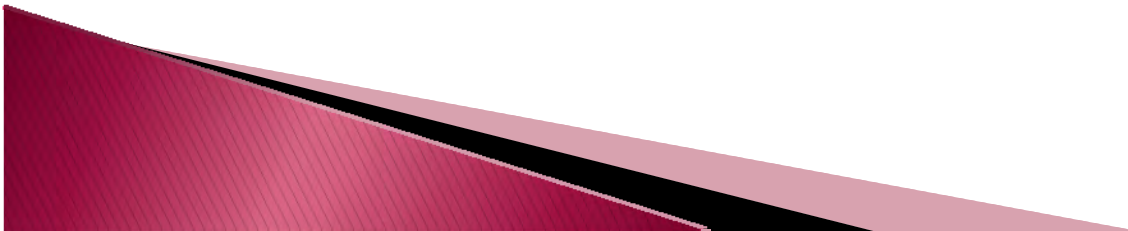


What are the goals of Title I?

 - ❖ Enable parents to be math and reading partners with their child.

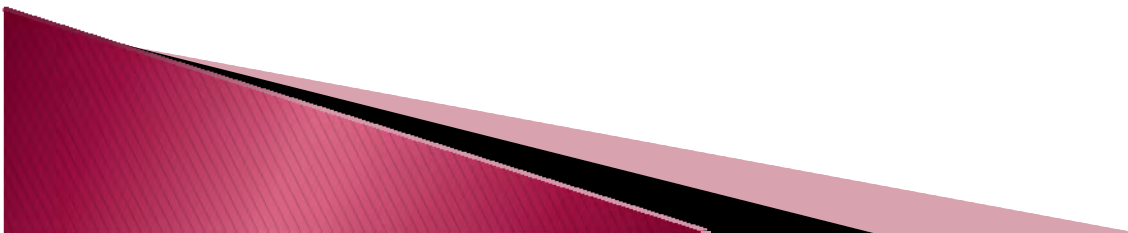
How does my child qualify for Title I?

- ❖ Standardized test scores
- ❖ Teacher/parent recommendation
- ❖ Student screening information and other current student data



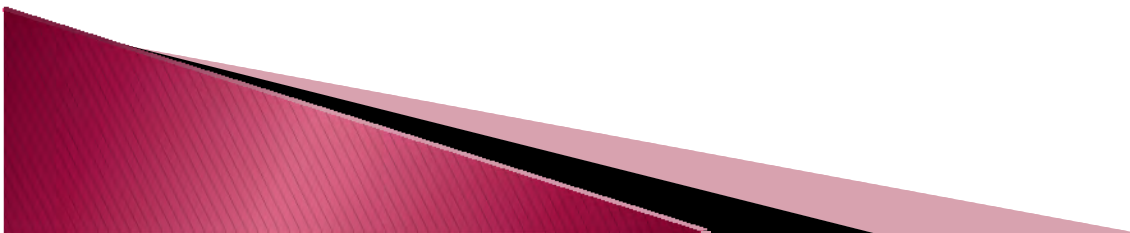
Will my child always be in the program?

- ❖ No
- ❖ We work closely with the classroom teacher to monitor students progress.
- ❖ When a student's reading or math achievement reaches their appropriate grade level, the student is dropped from the program if the Title I teachers and the classroom teacher feel the student no longer needs the extra support.



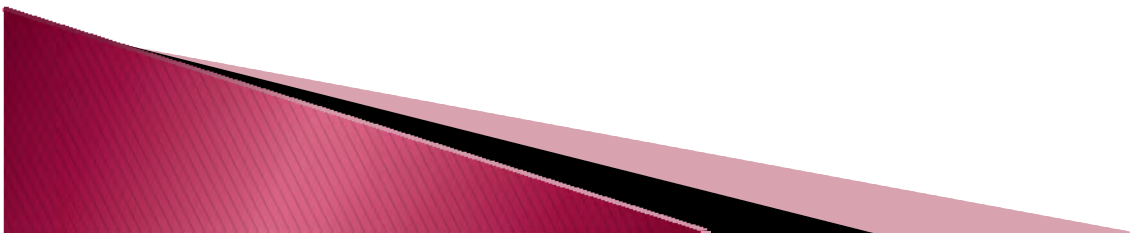
What does “Inclusion” mean?

- ❖ This means the student does not leave the classroom.
- ❖ Instead the Title I teacher comes into the regular classroom and works with students there.



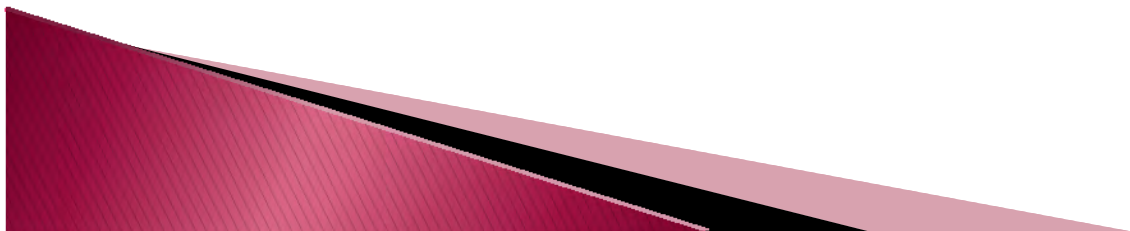
What does “Pull-out” mean?

- ❖ Students with a greater need are served through a pull-out-program.
- ❖ In the pull-out program, the students comes to the Title I room each day for additional instruction in reading or math. The student may come individually or with a small group of students.



How does Title I benefit my child?

- ❖ Title I personnel provide more intensive individualized instruction to those students who need it.
- ❖ Title I program has many supplies and resources for Title I students to use.
- ❖ Most importantly, Title I students experience success in the Title I program which increases self- esteem and motivation.
